Foundation Stage

Foundation Stage 2

- Baselines to be carried out in the first 3 weeks of the Autumn term using observations and pre school data.
- Baselines inputted onto Tapestry.
- Speech (Language Link) Assessments are on-going (Mrs Fox-LA).
- At the end of each half term summative assessments inputted into Tapestry.
- Observations are added to Tapestry daily based on Teacher and/or EYP observations (long and short).
- FS2 Phonic assessments as children reach the end of each phase (Letters and Sounds assessment sheets).
- Every Tuesday and Thursday morning throughout term (8:15am – 8:40am) open session available to parents/carers to use Tapestry.
- End of June 2017 – EYFS Profile Data to be entered.
