Holidays During Term Time

Please note that we will not grant holidays during term time.

Schools <u>used to</u> have the discretion to allow up to 10 days' term-time holiday each year in 'special circumstances'. The rules were tightened in Sept 2013 – now head teachers at state schools in England can only give permission for term-time absences in "exceptional circumstances".

Exceptional Circumstances are events or problems which you did not expect. For example, bereavement, unexpected personal or family problems or illness <u>might be</u> considered as an exceptional circumstance.

Headteachers <u>cannot and will not</u> authorise school absence purely for the reason of a family holiday.
