Contact details for parents are available and this information is reviewed every term to ensure it is up to date.</i> <i>A protocol is in place to deal with evacuation in an emergency. Details are recorded in the school fire risk assessment. Fire drills are carried out on a termly basis. Fire extinguishers are in place and serviced as part of the school contract.</i> <i>Appropriately trained first aiders and fire wardens are provided.</i>	<i>L</i>

The school's medication policy is followed and parental consent forms are provided where medication is required. Training is provided to staff according to individual care plans.</i> <i>Children with allergies are identified and all staff are made aware of this.</i>	<i>L</i>
