Dear Parents/Carers,

Thank you again for supporting us in the smooth operation of the start and end of the school day.

I'd like to bring your attention to a few things:

1. Face covering

Taking into account the national rise in Covid-19 cases, **if you able to**, we are asking adults to kindly wear a face covering whilst on our premises, to aid in protecting both yourself and others.

2. Social distancing

Again, taking into account the national rise in Covid-19 cases, please do social distance on the school's premises – 2metres apart. To minimise the number of people on our premises, only **one** adult should be bringing their child/ren to school. **We will be asking any additional adult/s to leave.**

We are doing all that we can to keep our school open.

3. School Times as from Monday 21st September onwards is as follows:-

9am – 3pm

4. Lates as from Monday 21st September onwards

As from Monday 21st September, the cut-off times for children coming to school late will be **9.11am**. All gates to the school premises will be locked at this time.

5. PE Days

PE day is every Tuesday. Children should come to school in a P.E Kit.

6. If your child is ill

What are the symptoms of coronavirus?

The virus can vary in seriousness. Symptoms may appear in as few as two days or as long as 14 days after exposure.

The main symptoms to look out for are:

- *A new continuous cough*
- *A high temperature*
- *Loss or change to your sense of smell or taste*

What should I do if I have coronavirus symptoms?

Your child should stay at home if they have any of the following symptoms:

- *A high temperature – child feels hot to touch on the chest or back*
- *A new, continuous cough – this means they've started coughing repeatedly*
- *Loss or change to sense of smell or taste – this means your child cannot smell or taste anything, or things smell or taste different to normal.*
