## Attendance

Gates open at 8.40am for registration at 8:50am. Children who arrive after this time are classed as late and this is marked on their attendance. Lates affect children's overall school attendance. Nursery times are 8:45am- 11:45am.

Please be aware that any child that drops below 90% attendance is classed as persistently absent. We can authorise absences with medical evidence. This can be an appointment card, text message regarding a medical appointment, medication with the date and child's name on or a letter.

We have brought back attendance tokens and Class of the Week for attendance! All children, who attend school Monday to Friday, with no lates, will receive an attendance token for their house team to put in the attendance tubes outside the school office.

The class with the highest attendance in KS1 and KS2 each week will receive a certificate. If your child's class collects 10 class certificates for attendance, they celebrate with a class party.
