What's been happening in school this term?

The children have enjoyed lots of exciting workshops and visits this half term. Nursery children and parents visited the local library to celebrate an Imagination Library Event. Year 4 visited Water's Edge to start their

topic of Land, Sea and Sky, where they looked at the features of the River Humber, different local habitats and their living things, as well as using data loggers to record environmental features. Year 5 and 6 participated in the workshop "No More Knives or County Lines." Children's author Christiana Gabbitas joined Humberside Police to deliver an engaging and informative workshop about the dangers of


