In an effort to help support you in this space, we are inviting you to participate in the **Digital Proficiency Course**, alongside our staff and pupils, through our Safer Schools App.

This unique whole-school course, created by safeguarding professionals at [INEQE Safeguarding Group](#) and Safer Schools, is designed to educate and empower everyone within the school community to be safer in a digital world.

All learning is built on creating foundational principles, covering the **5 C's of Online Risk** (Content, Contact, Conduct, Commerce, and Cyber Security), including **parental controls, Artificial Intelligence, Age Restrictions, and Catfishing**. The course is intended to raise awareness, increase your confidence and provide practical advice on how to help your child stay safer online.

As a school, we're encouraging our staff, our pupils and you, the parents and carers, to actively participate. Your involvement is a crucial part for us to successfully achieve the status of a **Certified Safer School**. In gaining this certification together, we will publicly show our collective commitment to safeguarding in a digital world.

You can access the **video-based course** in your **Safer Schools App** on Web and Mobile (under 'Digital Proficiency') from **5th February 2026**. You will receive a **certificate of completion** upon finishing the final test, and the school will be notified of your result.
