### As a parent/carer, I agree to:

- Recognise that good attendance is essential for my child's learning, wellbeing and future success.
- Inform school promptly if my child is absent.
- Support my child with reading, homework and practising key skills at home.

- Communicate with school staff respectfully and work in partnership with the school to support my child.
